



Snow Removal Operations Underway in Lucas Heights (Zone 1)

As Town of Ponoka crews continue working to remove snow from roadways throughout the community, snow removal operations are underway in Lucas Heights (Zone 1) **today, February 25 and tomorrow, February 26** along the following roadways:

- 60 Street from 57 Avenue to 52 Avenue;
- 61 Street from 57 Avenue to 54 Avenue;
- 62 Street from 50 Avenue to 54 Avenue;
- 54 Avenue from 54 Street to 65 Street;
- 55 Avenue from 61 Street to 65 Street;
- 53 Avenue from 60 Street to the end of the road;
- 64A Street from the close south of 53 Avenue to the close north of 54 Avenue;
- 64 Street from 55 Avenue to 54 Avenue;
- 53 Avenue from 60 Street into the close west of 64A Street;
- 52 Avenue from 60 Street to 63 Street; and
- 64A Street Close.

Snow and ice control crews are also sanding and clearing snow on sidewalks adjacent to Town-owned properties, as well as on walking trails and park furniture (benches, picnic tables, etc.) in Town parks and throughout the trail system.

‘No Parking’ Signs

Please watch for ‘No Parking’ signs and move parked vehicles from roads when the signs are posted.

Removing your vehicle from the roadway when ‘No Parking’ signs are posted in advance of snow removal operations is a requirement under the Town’s Traffic Bylaw and can result in fines and towing of the vehicle at the owner’s expense if needed.

Removing your vehicle from the road also helps crews conduct snow and ice control operations safely and more efficiently.

Community Advisory Signs

Community advisory signs are also posted 48 hours in advance in residential neighbourhoods to give residents notice of when snow removal is scheduled to occur in their area.



Please note that changing weather conditions and new snowfall events can require crews to direct their attention back to priority routes and delay planned snow removal operations. As a result, crews may not complete the entire zone and will return at a later date.
