When storing your kitchen scraps in your Kitchen Catcher, you can place organic waste directly into it without the use of any liner or you can use one of these acceptable liners:

- Newspaper or flyers
- Cardboard
- Paper bags
- Certified Compostable Bags

## Look for this Certification Symbol

Only certified compostable bags with the Biodegradable Products Institute or the COMPOSTABLE logos are accepted in the Green Bin / Cart program. Paper bags are also acceptable (no certification logos required).

Non-compostable plastic bags, even those labelled 'degradable', 'biodegradable' or 'oxo-degradable', are **NOT accepted**.

The following plastic bags are **NOT compostable and are NOT acceptable** in Ponoka's Green Bin / Cart program.

- Grocery or produce bags
- Transparent green, orange, blue and clear Leaf and Yard waste bags
